

Conditions of using the web site bulguides.com

These “General conditions of use”, as well as the corresponding laws and acts, are regulating the access and the use of the web site, bellow called “the Site”, of the Association “Bulgarian Mountain Guides”, bellow called “the Association”.

1. GENERAL CONDITIONS

1.1 These conditions settle the general rules of using the Site. With each use of the services and the resources of the Site, the users declare, that they are aware of the General conditions, they agree with them and they undertake to observe them.

1.2 The conditions may change at any time without notifying the users in advance.

2. DESCRIPTION OF THE SERVICES OF THE WEB SITE

2.1 The Site is used to represent the Association in front of the public, as well as to serve for achieving the aims, set in the Association’s Statute. All services, offered in the Site, are for achieving these aims.

2.2 The services offered by the Site are: access to data base with profiles of the mountain guides, who are members of the Association, opportunity for publishing materials and programs on the Site. The Site also offers subscription to the newsletter.

2.3 Every user has an access to the data base and to the uploaded materials, as well as to the service subscription to the newsletter. Only the Association’s members have access to the rest of the services: including publishing programs, profile in the data base and publishing other materials in the web site.

2.4 The Site has the right to change the technology and the design of the services offered without advance notification.

2.5 The site has the right to send to its users system messages about new services or changes in the conditions and the ways of using the present services.

2.6 The Association publishes on the Site information about Bulgarian mountains and the mountains worldwide, about interesting destinations and routs, as well as information connected to mountaineering and practicing mountain sports. In this way the Association is implementing the aims set in its Statute:

□ To ease the access to the information for the mountains in Bulgaria and all over the world and for the available variety of outdoor sports and activities in Bulgarian mountains.

□ To improve the mountaineering culture and the knowledge of the people who are visiting the mountains in Bulgaria and other countries.

□ To work on protecting the environment and improving the ecological knowledge of the mountain visitors in Bulgaria.

□ To make the Bulgarian mountains popular international destination and support the development of the mountaineering in all its varieties.

2.7 The association gives an opportunity to the mountain guides, who are members, to offer their services on the Association's web site, as well as to publish their own programs. In this way, the Association achieves the aims set in its Statute:

- To popularize the profession mountain guide in the society as well as the services offered by the mountain guides.
- To make the access and availability of the services offered by the mountain guides easier for Bulgarians and foreigners.

2.8 To have their programs published on the Association's web site, the mountain guides should meet the following criteria:

- To be members of the Association;
- Have valid mountain guide's diploma;
- Have passed the exam for legal capacity at the Ministry of tourism;
- Be registered in the National Touristic Register and possess an identity card;
- Offer programs, which corresponds to their qualification, according to the levels defined in the regulative documents;
- Have signed a declaration, with which they certify, that they are fully responsible (financially and else) for the services and programs they offer, as well as that they won't do any irregular tour operational activity through the Association's Site;
- Not to offer programs with total price, which includes other components than the guiding service – and that is: accommodation, transportation and other touristic services. All kinds of descriptions and prices for such services to be presented only as information for the users.

2.9 Through its Site, the Association performs a service, which is additional business activity, that is sale of touristic maps and itineraries. The incomes of this activity are being used for achieving the Association's main goals, described in its Statute.

3. RESPONSIBILITY

3.1 Neither the Association nor any other person involved in the creation, development or marketing of the Site is responsible for any losses, damages or expenses, direct, side, consequential, special or typical damages arising from the use of services offered by guides through the Site of the Association, unless such damage is a result of intentional fault on the part of the Association. Full liability for loss, damages and costs should be sought from the individual guide, offered the service.

3.2 The Association and respectively the Site are not a mediator between the guides and do not take part in the financial relationships between the guides and their clients and do not charge commissions and rates on the amounts received by the guides.

3.3 Neither the Association nor any other person involved in the creation, development or marketing of the Site is responsible for any losses, damages or expenses, direct, side, consequential, special or typical damages arising from the use of the Site (including liability for delays or inaccuracies in the transmission of information, interruption, suspension or termination of the display of this website), unless such damage is the result of intentional fault on the part of the Association.

3.4 The Site is not liable for the content, the truthfulness and the conformity with the law of references to Internet sites and services or resources, which are made available to the user while using the Site's services.

3.5 The users of the services understand, that the information, data, published opinions, text, software, music, sound, photos or any other materials (bellow called "Content"), which are made publicly available or are being transferred confidentially, are the sole responsibility of the person, who generates this Content. The Site does not guarantee the accuracy, the completeness, the truthfulness or the nature of this Content.
